Sir/Madam,

- 1. The Council had instituted the NEEM Scheme for providing on the job skill/ practical training to lesser privileged youth by active collaboration of Industry wherein you have been registered as a NEEM facilitator. The objective of the scheme is to prepare them so that the trainees are able to find subsequent employment post successful completion of training period.
- 2. It is clarified that the scheme is not intended to be used as substitute for employment in any form. To the contrary, the scheme is intended to educate and train the future workforce by collaboration of NEEM Facilitators & Industrial establishments.
- 3. However, it has been brought to the notice of Council that certain NEEM Facilitators are engaging in activities wherein existing employees of industrial establishments are being re-routed as NEEM trainees thereby exploiting exemptions from statutory deductions of PF/ ESI as made under the provisions of NEEM Scheme. The Council does not approve of such practices & hereby cautions/advises all NEEM Facilitators to abide by the regulation in true letter and spirit.
- 4. It is reiterated that the scheme is to provide NSQF compliant training for enhancement of skill to youth. It would be in fitness of things that such training is also assessed & certified at the end of contractual training period.
- 5. Any NEEM Facilitator found misusing provisions of NEEM Scheme and indulging in any malpractices shall be de-registered immediately and decision of Council will be final & binding. You are thus advised to comply with the provisions. ours faithfully

Sub: Realigning of Neem Activities to Higher Educational Institutions

Sir/Madam;

- 1. Refer our advisory issued vide AICTE letter No F No 3-1/D-SDC/ NEEM/ 2019 dated 05th September 2019
- 2. The matter concerning the functioning of NEEM facilitators has been reviewed by the Council in consultation with MHRD. It has been decided to strictly align the activities of the NEEM with higher educational institutes wherein all future trainees under NEEM shall be students who are pursuing studies from higher educational institutes (bachelor level and beyond) for developing their skills in order to enhance their future employability. Henceforth, no fresh enrolment of trainees falling into categories such as those from drop out or completed or having education from 8 to 12 class are to be enrolled by any NEEM facilitators.
- 3. Further, until a comprehensive decision regarding the re-structuring of the NEEM scheme is arrived at by MIIRD, no extension of approval shall be granted to the existing NEEM facilitators. Where approvals have already expired, such NEEM facilitators are advised not to enrol any new/ fresh trainees. In such cases, only the existing trainees are to be continued with and progressively phased out on completion of the contractual period of training between the NEEM trainee & NEEM facilitator. In effect all such cases where the approvals have expired/ will expire shall restrict their activities to the set of trainees already contracted.
 - 4. It is also clarified that all cases for extension of approval shall be considered only after the new NEEM scheme is notified.
